The sessions refined the Public speaking, presentation skills, E-mail Etiquette, Grooming and Group Discussion skills of the students.Each day the trainer took some topics which he had outlined in the training programme and thought and made the students practice it during the sessions. This programme helped students to increase their chances to get succeed in the job interview as well as to achieve heights in the career ladder. The training programme has taught them that an error does not become a mistake until we refuse to correct it. The sessions ended with feedback, and the trainer later stated that certificates will be distributed to participants within two days.


