INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO NRSC

Avanthi P.G. College organized an **Industrial visit to NRSC**, Jeedimetla in collaboration with TASK on 1st April, 2022. The objective of the industrial visit was to make students aware on how various testing, remote sensing, and satellite activities are carried out in companies and to give them a sense of corporate culture.









Mr. T. Shankar Prasad, Scientist, NRSC, gave us an overview of the company's history and how it was founded, as well as showing us movies connected to the space programme. They have explained clearly how the communication will be going on in the organization. They showed us the pictures which had been took from the Indian satellites exclusively. They even compared the pictures of American Satellites with our satellites. After this, it was followed by visiting the campus and they even exhibited the demo satellites of ISRO and explained about the parts of the satellites and functioning of satellites.

Students gained a thorough understanding of the NRSC's exploratory investigations on weather and climate, as well as monitoring and supervision of natural resources, allowing the students to bridge the gap between academic learning and practical experience.

A TWO DAY SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

ON MICROSOFT EXCEL

Two day workshop was organized on Microsoft Excel in collaboration with TASK on was organized on April 17th -18th, 2022. Mr. Balu Banothu was the trainer for the workshop. On day one The trainer introduced the use of simple functions like sum, average, product, division, max, min, text functions and various ways of formatting the entered data, explaining lucidly with the help of the dataset shared with the students later he extended the discussion on the use of standard operators like AVERAGEIF, COUNTIF, and mathematical and statistical functions, which helped work out a number of problems from the data set. Next day the trainer taught them sorting and filtering, Lookup functions, Data validation he also taught the various paste special techniques that are available with EXCEL and also took up the topics of creating charts and slicers, how to protect an excel worksheet and also the various tools of data analysis in EXCEL the session ended with the trainer giving some practice problems to solve.
