Under this programme, students will have the opportunity to be coached by trainers to improve their skills, which will dramatically increase their chances of success in a job interview.			
9.	Outcomes	The training programme will helped students in taking their initial steps into the corporate world, as well as increasing their chances of success in job interviews.			
10.	Description	The session started by the trainer explaining the student about Employability Skills training programme. During the session he discussed what one should need to learn for their interpersonal skills. The training programme was conducted by the certified trainer Mr. Fayazoddin. The training methodology was followed with a brief introduction about the topic followed by practical activity to drive the points covered on each topic in the minds of all the participants. The sessions refined the Public speaking, presentation skills, E-mail Etiquette, Grooming and Group Discussion skills of the students. Each day the trainer took some topics which he had outlined in the training programme and thought and made the students practice it during the sessions. This programme helped students to increase their chances to get succeed in the job interview as well as to achieve heights in the career ladder. The training programme has taught them that an error does not become a mistake until we refuse to correct it. The sessions ended with feedback, and the trainer later stated that certificates will be distributed to participants within two days.
